

Schedule of Warranty

- SELLER:** Syston Rolling Shutters Ltd t/a Syston Doors – for the purpose of this Schedule of Warranty hereinafter called Syston Doors.
- SCOPE:** All Goods sold by Syston Doors in the UK (including spare parts).
- DURATION:** Goods – 12 months from completion of installation.
Spare Parts – 12 months from date of replacement.
- REMEDY:** 1) Defective Goods or Component Parts thereof will be repaired or replaced by Syston Doors in-situ.
- LIMITATIONS:**
- 1) Doors must have been installed in accordance with Syston Doors Drawings and Installation Manuals and by Syston Doors approved installers.
 - 2) Doors must be continuously maintained in accordance with Syston Doors Operation, Safety and Maintenance manuals by Syston Doors or any other company, who at the time of such maintenance or service was recognised as competent by Syston Doors to carry out such works. The decision of Syston doors shall be final. Evidence of maintenance will be required.
 - 3) Goods must be used for the purpose they were intended, so that accident damage, vandalism, improper use or operation, incorrect maintenance, the use of spare parts or exchange units not supplied by Syston Doors or the incorporation of modifications not conforming to Syston Doors specifications shall invalidate the right to remedy under Syston Doors Warranty and all costs to Syston Door's doors as a result of any of the above will be chargeable.
 - 4) In the event of the replacement of defective component parts then such replacement may at Syston Doors option be limited exclusively to new value repaired and / or reconditioned goods or component parts and not factory new goods or component parts.
- EXCLUSIONS:**
- 1) Labour costs incurred by the buyer or his agent for any reason whatsoever.
 - 2) Any other direct / indirect costs.
 - 3) Compensation for direct / indirect damage and / or consequential loss.
- GENERAL:**
- 1) Syston Doors alone shall decide whether or not a claim falls within the terms of this warranty, and such decision shall be binding on the Buyer.
 - 2) All Goods or Component Parts, which are removed from the door in the event of a warranty claim, shall become the property of Syston Doors.
 - 3) Where Goods or Component Parts are inspected by Syston Doors as a result of a claim, but Syston Doors decides that the claim doesn't fall within the terms of the warranty, then any Component Parts removed shall become the property of Syston Doors unless at the time the Buyer submits his claim he requests that they be made available to him.
 - 4) Syston Doors accept no liability in respect of any claims made against the Buyer from the use or resale of Goods, either as originally sold by Syston Doors or otherwise.
 - 5) Except as originally set out in this Warranty, or as otherwise provided in Syston Doors Conditions of Sale all conditions and warranties, statutory or otherwise and expressed or implied, relating to the quality of the Goods or their fitness for any purpose are hereby excluded.
